Dear Professor Carter

I wish to clarify the volunteering component of the Bachelor of Counselling degree as offered by ACAP and accredited by ACA.

The volunteering component is a mandatory component of the ACAP Bachelor of Counselling (including Coaching Minor).

This applies to all students starting their studies in T1 2020 onwards and is optional for students currently in their 2nd and 3rd year.

Upon graduation, when applying for ACA membership, students will need to inform ACA if they are yet to complete these voluntary hours.

If the service-learning unit is not studied, an additional 50 hours is required bringing the total of voluntary hours to 140.
