How to Apply

Ensure the prospective student has accurate information about (but not limited to):

- Their intended course and studies with ACAP and studying in Australia, and provide them with a copy/link to our course guide.
- The course duration, tuition fees, whether the course has placement requirements, intake period(s), and minimum admission requirement, including IELTS requirements (see Course summary table)

Step 1

Complete the International Student Application Form on our website at acap.edu.au/international-students/how-to-apply-international (the form must be signed by the applicant)

Step 2

The applicant must complete (ideally in their own handwriting), the International Student Statement of Purpose Form.

Step 3

Attach certified copies of all academic qualifications including school and Academic English language test results and any relevant employment documents. Please ensure that the applicant's current name is added to any documents obtained under a former name and that certified translations accompany documents that are not in English. Please note, translation of official documents must be completed by an accredited translator.

Step 4

Submit the Application form and any relevant statements (please refer to course entry requirements on our website acap.edu.au) via email: NPI.International@navitas.com.

Step 5

To assess the application, the applicant may need to speak to a staff member either via telephone, face-to-face or via Skype. If we do need to talk to the applicant, we will be in contact to arrange a suitable time.

Step 6

If successful, the applicant will receive a Letter of Offer – Acceptance Agreement from ACAP, within approximately five working days, explaining the course offered, any conditions if attached to the offer, how to enrol and the commencement date. The applicant may be requested to provide additional evidence and declarations to the College as part of Step 7 below.

Step 7

To accept, please return the signed Letter of Offer – Acceptance Agreement (signed by the applicant), NPI International Student Financial Declaration, completed and signed by the applicant in the presence of an authorised witness, as well as any other requested documentation.

Step 8

On receipt of the signed Letter of Offer - Acceptance Agreement and completed and witnessed Financial Declaration, subject to the applicant meeting any other offer conditions outlined in the Letter of Offer (if applicable), a place at ACAP will be confirmed in writing and approval to pay the fees outlined in the Letter of Offer (these fees will include, but are not limited to, a non-refundable Enrolment fee of AUD \$250, tuition fees and, if applicable your Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) fees). Upon receipt of these fees, you will then receive a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE). This CoE must be submitted with the application for a student visa to be given.
